### ART CONTEST

Artists are invited to enter one to three, of their original works in the Pioneer Day Art Contest.

Adult artist entry fee for first work is \$20. The second and third entrees are \$10 each. Student (12-19) entry fee for first work is \$10. The second **and third** entrees are \$5 each. Entry fees are nonrefundable.

All drawings, pastels, watercolors, should be matted and framed behind glass or other appropriate material. Gallery wrapped canvasses will be accepted as long as there are no visible staples **and edges are painted**; other canvases (flat or those with staples) must be framed. Works must hang by a secured wire. **The toothed hanger clips are not acceptable.** Framed works must not exceed 44 inches in height or width. Sculptures may not exceed 4'x4'x4'. 3-Dimensional work must be stabilized when on display. (You will need to provide your own pedestal/stand for 3-Dimensional work)

A completed entry card must be attached to the back of each work. The Pioneer Day Art Committee reserves the right to final discretion regarding approval of the works selected for exhibition based upon appropriateness of content.

### **DROP OFF**

Art works will be accepted for display at the Fort Mitchell Visitors Center at the following times.

FRIDAY APRIL 5, 2019 11:00 am -- 4:00 pm SATURDAY APRIL 6, 2019 10:00 am -- 4:00 pm SUNDAY APRIL 7, 2019 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm

Every precaution will be exercised in the handling of the entries. However, the Russell County Historical Commission will not be responsible for any damage or loss.

Works must be claimed during pick up time on Sunday April 14, 2019, between 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm only. If unable to pick up work at designated time, please contact Naomi Elliott (706 573 1016) or Dell McLendon (706 577 3327. Proper I.D. is required of anyone picking up artwork.

Woks claimed by someone other than the artist require a note with:

- > Title of the work
- ➤ Name of the person picking up Signature of the artist
